

Marco Gobbi The Vibrant Vessels

For his first solo exhibition Marco Gobbi (Brescia, 1985) presents The Vibrant Vessels, this project was developed in all its parts during the recent stay at the Van Eyck Academy in Maastricht.

The Vibrant Vessels consists of a series of objects / sculpture that the artist created following the idea of wanting to give a shape to the sound of the sea. Fascinated by the chance to hear the sound of the sea approaching a shell to the ear, Marco Gobbi has developed the concepts of melancholy and lack proper to

this action.

Marco Gobbi's artistic practice is based on memory as a reminder and as time physical stratification. Marco Gobbi shapes objects, usually from waste materials, transforming them into episodes or images fixed in his memory. His works crystallize and return in a unique memory structure, imagery and sensations from which they are generated. His sculptures and installations are projections in a poetic form of thought processes, logical paths and narratives.
